Mandatory Covid-19-Related Safety Measures for EAJ and Partners Funder by EAJ

1 October 2020

The intention of these measures is to ensure a safe return to human-contact related justice activities by EAJ and the partners it is funding, including workshops, meetings and events, and in-person justice assistance provision, as well as any remote work set out in this application.

EAJ and its partners are all committed to ensuring that all human-contact activities in a manner that does not compromise COVID-19-related requirements by putting into place the following mandatory measures aimed at preventing viral spread-

1. Restrictions of numbers of persons participating in meetings. This should be restricted to 15 persons per meeting/event to ensure that social distancing and other measures put in place can be effectively managed.
2. Planning of all meetings and events to ensure that COVID-19 related preventions measures have been planned and communicated to all participants
3. Planning of safe travel for partner staff and participants to avoid public transport which does not provide adequate safety measures
4. Provision of masks, sanitizers or handwashing facilities for all engagements while observing USAID Guidance on Procuring Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)/ Covered Material.
5. Provision of COVID-19 safety messaging at the start of all engagements

These measures will be mandatory and applicable to the events and activities that EAJ and partners is implementing under this grant in particular-

- The program manager and lawyers training.
- The JP trainings
- The 3 justice stakeholders advocacy forums. And,
- 45 community awareness sessions including road shows

EAJ and its partners are committed to implementing these measures until such time as they are revised or lifted. This includes a situation in which stricter restrictions may need to be imposed or the grant will need to be suspended or terminated, as per Pact and/or USAID directions.
